The stunning views through Glen Truim take you to Catlodge and then it is downhill to the second stop at Laggan (lunch stop?) where fresh fruit is available. Then it is on to Loch-an-Uvie for the 'Water Stop' before heading back to Kingussie via Newtonmore.
